




Also known as the Festival of Lights, this eight-day Jewish celebration commemorates the retaking of the temple in Jerusalem in the 2nd century BCE

December 26-January 1- Kwanzaa.

A uniquely African-American celebration created in 1966, this seven-day festival reinforces connectedness to African cultural identity and is dedicated to the principles of unity, self-determination, collective work and responsibility, cooperative economics, purpose, creativity, and faith.
